CALL FOR CULTURAL WORKSHOP FACILITATOR SUBMISSIONS

The Regina 2014 North American Indigenous Games are currently accepting applications for unique Aboriginal, Métis, Inuit and Native American workshops / presentations to be considered for the Cultural Village, July 21-26, 2014. The Cultural Village is an all ages FREE family event.

The Cultural & Ceremonies Department is producing a festival that will celebrate Indigenous cultures from throughout North America. The Tipi Village portion of the Cultural Village will showcase the diversity of Indigenous cultures through facilitated workshops, which are designed to educate and inform the general public by demonstrating and teaching about Indigenous culture through arts, crafts and traditional methods. The Cultural Village will be an exciting opportunity for the Games participants to gather and celebrate; as well as a chance for cross cultural learning for tourists and visitors.

Over 6 days there will be 28 tipis put up at the First Nations University of Canada with cultural workshops related to activities, such as singing, chanting, drumming, dancing, Indigenous languages, beading, moccasin making, tipi raising, storytelling, traditional food preparation, etc. There will also be an open area available for traditional hand games and Indigenous sport demos.

Please forward your submission to the attention of the Culture and Ceremonies Department for consideration by our selection committee. Successful applicants will be contacted directly. The deadline for workshop facilitators will be February 28, 2014.
